HOPE (Health through Outreach, Personal Perspectives, and Engagement)

Joseph Maley Foundation's HOPE program brings emotional, physical, social and mental health awareness and empowerment to students. HOPE equips students with tools to live healthy lifestyles and advocate for their health and the health of their peers.

Advocacy Sponsor - \$2000

HOPE brings emotional, physical, social and mental health awareness and advocacy to students in preschool through twelfth grades. The program equips students with advocacy tools using engaging activities, discussion opportunities, dynamic speakers, performances by the Joseph Maley Friends Puppet Troupe, and literacy components. A full-year program exposes participants to each pillar of the HOPE program: Social Health, Mental Health, Emotional Health, and Physical Health.

Pillar Sponsor - \$750

The HOPE program is implemented through four pillars: social, emotional, mental, and physical. Each pillar (grades preK through 12) contains literacy components, question and response activities, writing lessons, and physical activities that reinforce the theme presented. These pillars can be presented as a standalone option or incorporated into a year-long HOPE program featuring all four components.

Interaction Sponsor - \$250

During this time of hybrid learning in our schools, our HOPE program has incorporated new features that actively engage students. Sponsoring an interactive experience allows students to participate in live Q & A sessions with our talented community of mental health speakers and Joseph Maley Friends puppets via Zoom or Google Classroom.
